## Spelling

## Design and Technology

This half term we have been looking at pasta in DT with the idea of designing and making our own pasta bake. Why not develop your skills in the kitchen?

- You could practise preparing a range of vegetables correctly.
- You could follow a familiar recipe and make a slight change.
- You could find a recipe from somewhere else in the world and make it.

## Writing and drawing

Produce a fun and colourful leaflet about our local area and persuade people to visit. Include pictures, maps and interesting facts about places tourists could visit.



Make sure your map has a title, a key, map symbols, a compass rose and colours to show different landmarks.

## Photography and painting

Take a photograph or paint your favourite local landscape scene. (you can even use mixed media or collage)



## Geography

Choose a food that is grown or produced somewhere else in the world and track its journey to your home. You can represent the steps however you want. Remember to think about human involvement and how the food gets from one place to another.



## Computing

Using Google Sites, produce a web page about our local area. It could be an advert, information about an event from the past that happened in Somerset, or something else entirely!

Maybe you could think about what tourist attractions people may want to visit, what advice you might give them and the pictures that would look most appealing!
