Task: Create a small diorama that shows how a community uses natural resources sustainably.



Why do we need natural, sustainable resources to support a successful community?

Materials

- A shoebox or small box
Recycled materials (cardboard, paper, bottle lids, boxes, foil)
Glue or tape
Markers or labels
Natural items (optional): leaves, twigs, soil, small stones

Your diorama must include:

At least 3 natural resources, such as water, sunlight, plants/trees, soil, wind

At least 2 labelled sustainable features, such as: Solar panels - use sunlight to make electricity without pollution.

Wind turbines - use natural energy.

Gardens or farms - uses soil, water, and sunlight to grow food.

Rainwater tanks-saves water for plants.

Recycling bins - helps sustainability and there is less landfill




