


Warfare was an important part of Anglo-Saxon life. Battles were often fought on foot with warriors engaging in hand-to-hand combat.

- Research an Anglo-Saxon Artefact-Find out about the artefacts found at Sutton Hoo or Mildenhall. Explain what the artefact is and why you think it was buried at **Sutton Hoo or Mildenhall.**
