Week One

We've learnt about suffixes at the end of words, nouns and verbs.

-s as plural marker for nouns – chairs, books, flowers

-es as plural marker for nouns that end in ch, sh, s, x, z – foxes, brushes, churches

-s as a third person singular marker for verbs – thinks, jumps, paints

-es as a third person singular marker for verbs that end in ch, sh, s, x, z – wishes, brushes, mixes

We will be revisiting these each week and learning to using them in our writing during our English lessons.
