## Week Two

We've learnt about suffixes at the end of words, nouns and verbs.

### **-ing adding to verbs.**

We learnt that a verb is an action/doing word.

We learnt to read and spell the words with the suffix **-ing**. Some examples are below:

jumping, growling, raining,  
groaning, beeping, showering,  
resting, scrunching, helping,  
clashing, frothing.
