Week Five

We've learnt about the prefix that can be placed at the beginning of words and finding the root word.

-un adding to verbs.

We learnt that a verb is an action/doing word.

We learnt to read and spell the words with the prefix **-un**. Some examples are below:

untwist, unpick, unfair, unpack,
unplug, undress, unload, unwell,
unzip, unlock

-un adding to adjectives.

We learnt to read and spell the words with the prefix **-un** being added to adjectives, we learnt that an adjective is a describing word. Some examples are below:

unfit, unclear, unfinished,
unpick, uncooked, unhelpful,
unafraid, unexpected, unwell,
unpacked.

We have also been practicing to read our common exception words.
