We've been learning about reading and writing contractions. We learnt that two words can be put together using an apostrophe (').

We learnt to read and spell words with the following contractions:

'll – I'll, they'll, she'll, you'll

n't – hadn't, aren't, wasn't, didn't, haven't

're – we're, they're, you're,

'd – he'd, I'd, they'd, we'd, she'd

We talked about how on some of the words we have to know the common exception word then add the contraction. We also talked about the second word that makes the contraction.

'll – will

n't – not

're – are

'd - would
